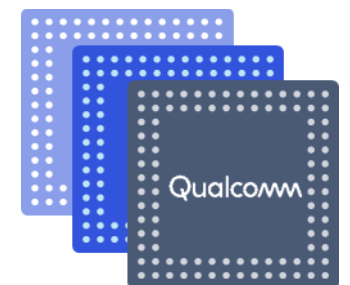

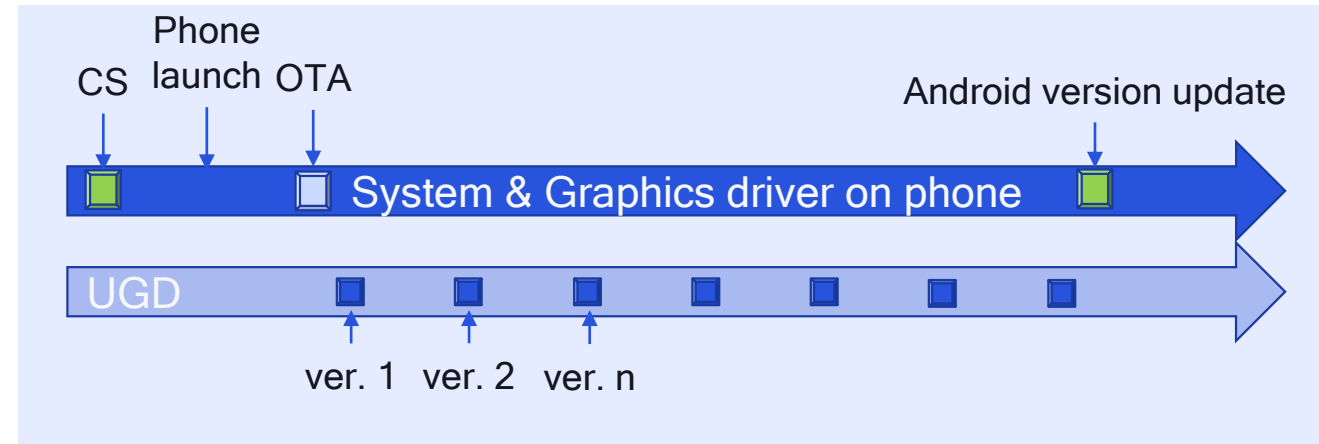
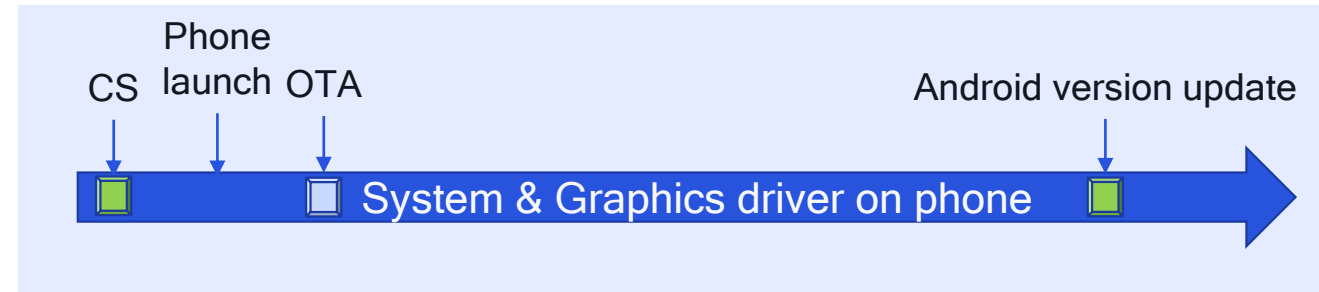

Updatable Graphics Drivers—How it works

- Key elements
 - Additional Graphics Driver
 - Updatable from the play store(app store)
 - Cadence is independent of OTA
 - Only OpenGL ES and Vulkan
 - Whitelist of games
 - Limited to using the updatable graphics driver
 - Blacklist of games
 - Forced to use the original graphics driver from system upgrade

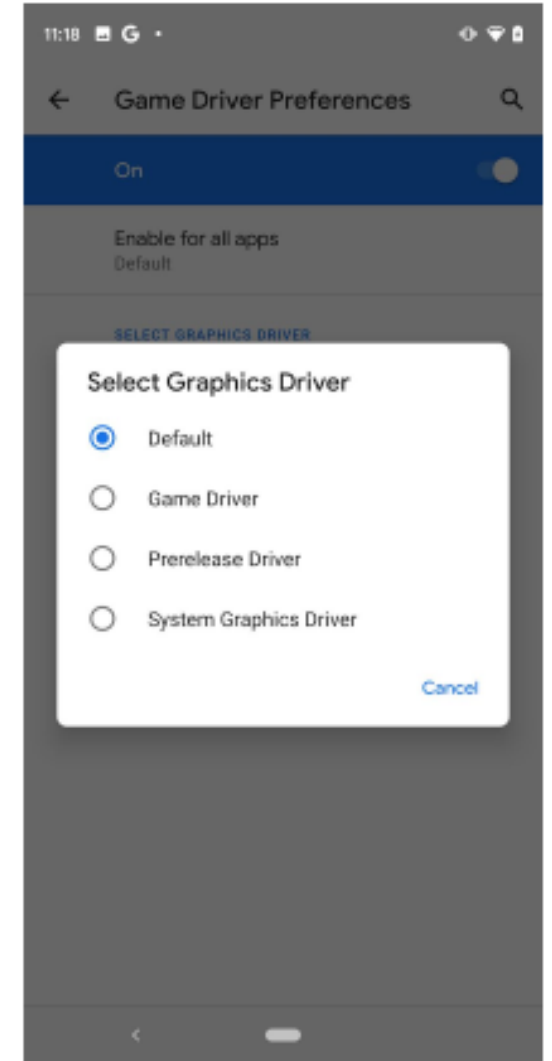


Updatable Graphics Drivers—Availability

- Starting from Android Q
- It is firstly supported on some SDM865 devices
- OEMs and Qualcomm to determine whitelist for a specific phone/project
- Blacklist managed by OEM for disaster fallback

Developer Driver for Game Developers

- Developer Driver is a pre-release version of Updatable Graphics Driver.
- Ability to test out the bug fixes, performance improvements and new features from Qualcomm on specific OEM devices.
- Once verified to work as expected on the Developer Driver, game developer can remove workaround in the game (if any) and release new version.
- Some new extensions and new features might be first available on Developer Driver.
- Some advanced features of tools such as “Android GPU Inspector” need to work with Updatable Graphics Driver.



How to Get Developer Driver From Qualcomm

- One account for each game studio. Different studios in the same company can apply different accounts.
- Provide below information to ugd.chinapartner@qti.qualcomm.com, we will run the certification process. If passed, you will receive an email to guide you how to download the Developer Driver.
- Information needed:
 - Contact/POC Name (Both Chinese and English)
 - Company Name (Both Chinese and English)
 - Studio Name (Both Chinese and English)
 - Email Address
 - Target use cases (choose all that applies, and can add others)
 - GLES game
 - Vulkan game
 - New feature/extension
 - Tools
